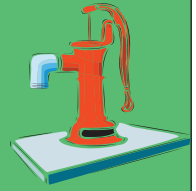


The Wombourne, Swindon, Penn & Kinver PARISH PUMP

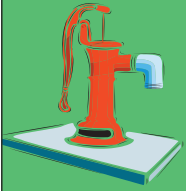

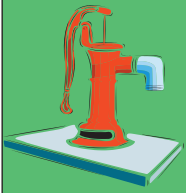

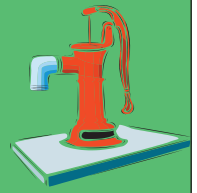
