it's a fact!

★ Animal rights activists are not a new phenomenon. On 23rd February 1891 a lecture about the Church Anti-Vivisection League was given in West Coseley School. The meeting was conducted by the Reverend J.P. Wright of Bridgnorth who suggested that—at times, direct action against vivisectionists may be the most appropriate action to take!

★ In April 1883 a miner called William Kinsey was sentenced to imprisonment for nine months after committing a series of assaults whilst “made drunk” a few days before. He apparently threw pieces of ironstone at about 20 women in Lower Gornal rendering several insensible and dangerously injuring others. The court heard that when he was arrested Kinsey feigned madness and he had to be carried to the police station. The injuries to 12 of the women were serious enough to stop them from working for a number of days.

★ One of the most unusual buildings in the centre of Gornal Wood is the ex-bakery in Prospect Road. It was originally built in 1900 by Ben Williams as a two storey factory where hearth furniture (mainly fire irons and fenders) were manufactured. Williams had learnt his trade as a colliery blacksmith and used his considerable skills to build up a sizeable business. He also—as a sideline—leased a considerable acreage of fields locally and then took over Ruiton Farm. Failing profits from his factory decided him to close down the company (known as B. Williams & Sons) in 1924 and he sold the building to Rupert Griffiths who converted it into a bakery.

DID YOU KNOW?

After the Birmingham New Road was opened in 1927, Coseley UDC arranged for trees to be planted on both sides of the road. The trees were dedicated to those from the area who had lost their lives in the First World War. Each tree had a plaque attached with the name of the victims remembered in this way.

Sedgley Wake was always celebrated in early November. During the week-long festival workplaces would close, many weddings would take place and sporting events held.

Although Sedgley's Bull Ring is well known, it is often forgotten that Gornal also had an area where bull baiting took place. It is not known exactly where it was—although it is likely to have been around Five Ways.

On Sunday, 30th December 1792, 264 poor families from Sedgley and 31 from Himley—a grand total of 923 individuals—were entertained at Himley Hall by Viscount Dudley and his family. Each person received 2lb of bread, 2lb of beef and a pint of strong broth.

In 1933 Beacon Cycles, based at High Holborn in the middle of Sedgley offered a total of 10 'Beacon' models from the 'Roadster' costing £3/19s/6d to the 'Flyweight' at £7/10s/0d.

Although normally life in the Workhouse was pretty dreadful at least at Christmas there was some relief from the routine and treats for everyone. This included a full Christmas lunch with all the trimmings which was served by the workhouse staff dressed in fancy dress.

For many years the Gibbons Works in Deepdale Lane, Lower Gornal ran its own railway system on the site. It had two steam locomotives named 'Emily Gibbons' and 'Gibbons 1920'.







DON'T FORGET TO CARE FOR YOUR FISH!

With the cold weather now upon us it is worthwhile remembering that fish in garden ponds are particularly vulnerable to predation from herons.

The number of herons in the areas has over the years increased dramatically and with food harder to come by they are now often seen trying to take fish from garden ponds. Many of these unwelcome visitors are juvenile birds and as well as feeding their hunger, they also practice their hunting techniques. The result is they may well kill a lot more fish than they actually need. The best way of thwarting these killing machines is to cover the pond with a net. It is also worthwhile trying to make sure that there is not a clear 'flight path' into the pond (they are such big birds that they need a lot of room to land safely).

There have been a few reports of another ace fisherman—the Kingfisher—making an appearance in a few local gardens. Whilst it is always thrilling see such a beautiful creature it too can easily clear a pond of fish within minutes. To reduce the likelihood of this happening make sure that there are no obvious perches from which the bird could launch itself.





- ★ The Ellowes Pub in Ellowes Road, Lower Gornal was renamed the Spriggers Arms by landlord Malcolm White. The name was in memory of his grandfather—Sprigger White—who played in goal for Ayr during the 1900s. At the time he held the record for the fewest goals conceded in a season.
- ★ There was great controversy over a football match between Pensnett Victoria and Woodsetton in the Sedgley & District League back in 1901. The match ended in a 2-2 draw but the referee sent a report to the League saying that he only allowed Pensnett's second goal (the ball had gone out of play before it entered the goal) because he was intimidated by the spectators. The League awarded the game to Woodsetton but—perhaps surprisingly—did not impose any sanctions on the referee.
- ★ In 1940 during the Second World War 12 people died in Tipton as a result of a 'friendly fire' incident. The people were part of a wedding party who were holding a reception at a nearby pub after the wedding ceremony at the Parish Church. At around 8.50pm an anti-aircraft shell that had been fired from a battery at Tividale crashed through the roof of the pub and exploded. Those killed included Florence Lily Jones, Richard and David Pottinger, Albert Danks, Gordon Monks, Margaret Stanway and Ethel Gough. The licensee and his wife (Mr and Mrs Samuel Hedley) escaped with only minor injuries.
- ★ In 1845 no fewer than 47 defendants with the surname Bates appeared at the magistrates' court in Sedgley.

Alex Bell played keyboards with Sofia Whitehouse on vocals. Also on vocals were Mike Croutear from Queen Reloaded and Alan’s fellow band mate Mark Davies from Moosejaw

Everyone involved with this project has freely given their time and Alan has done all of the recording and offered his studios free of charge. The object is quite simply to raise as much money for children’s charities as they can via downloads and streams. CDs will also be available and a video (edited by Philippa Davies and assisted by Jess Skidmore) has been recorded which is now available to view on YouTube. The song is available to download on most major streaming apps and platforms.

The group are hoping that the song will become a future favourite and, fingers crossed, that it also makes the charts. All they need is enough interest and promotion which they are constantly striving to get—if there is anyone out there who has any ideas of further promotion the team are always willing to listen.

What do you remember about COSELEY?
The Clifton Cinema which was built in 1938 and closed in 1963.

The Apple Tree pub in Castle Street which reputedly served the best pint of Banks's in the whole of Coseley

The day (18th February 1986) that Darby's fish shop next door to the Royal Hotel collapsed.

Arthur Davis' bicycle shop.

The Summer House pub which had a maze laid out in its rear garden.

The Old Coseley Council House (which was sadly demolished in 1968).

Page's Picture House—later called The Cosy Cinema – which later became the Ex Servicemen's Club.

The Cookery Centre at Mount Pleasant School.

The day that the 'Cannon' finally closed (31st March 1994) having been established in Coseley as long ago as 1826.

Mobberley's Brick Works in Upper Ettingshall Road

The Cobbler's shop (which was more of a shack) at the Foxyards crossroads.

The opening of the Silver Jubilee Park on 30th May 1936.

The old police station in Avenue Road which was demolished in 1975...and the Fire Station in Green Street.

And most recently, of course, Coseley Swimming Baths.

We hope that these evoked a few memories. All being well there will be more "memories" in the New Year.

FOR REINDEER READ GOAT!



If anyone tells you that they have seen Santa's sleigh being pulled by a team of reindeer don't believe them! In fact since ancient times it has been pulled by two goats!

The suggestion that the sleigh is powered by eight reindeer called Dasher, Dancer, Prancer, Vixen, Comet, Cupid, Donder and Blitzen comes from an American poem entitled "*A Visit From St. Nicholas*" by Clement Moore and published in 1823. Before this it was generally accepted that the sleigh was pulled by two magical goats called Gnasher and Cracker. This comes from ancient Norse mythology in which it is said that Thor, the God of Thunder was pulled on his chariot by two goats. Through this tale goats became revered and it was said that if you were to put a goat on its head on New Year's Eve you would have good luck for the next year. The Moore poem, however, introduced the idea that it was reindeer that pulled Santa's sleigh and in America at least, this became the widely accepted story. The reindeer were described as "tiny" and not at all like the traditional Caribou-type animals depicted in most films since including the very popular 1994 version of "*Miracle on 34th Street*". In New Brunswick, Canada there is a range of peaks known since 1964 as the "*Christmas Mountains*". There are a total of 10 separate peaks in the range—eight of which are named after the reindeer in Moore's poem. The other two are North Pole Mountain and Mount St. Nicholas.

★ On 15th December 1869 the local press reported “considerable satisfaction is expressed by the peaceably inclined inhabitants (of Sedgley) at the vigorous steps taken by the police to abate the riotous conduct of drunken fellows parading the streets during the small hours of the night and disturbing those who have gone to rest. On Monday at the Police Court Edward Lavender and Thomas Lavender, two old offenders, were charged with drunken and disorderly conduct at half past 12. When requested by PC White to desist and go home they refused and continued their noisy behaviour.” Edward Lavender was fined 40 shillings and costs. Thomas Lavender was fined 30 shillings and costs. In both cases they were warned that if the fines were not paid they would be imprisoned.

★ Complaints about public transport in the Black Country are nothing new. Back in 1898 there were reports of “utmost dissatisfaction” with the Dudley and Wolverhampton trams. It was said that there were regular breakdowns as “many intending passengers to Sedgley have had to tramp the journey on foot”. One correspondent in the Dudley Herald said: “The dilapidated engines still continue their inglorious career amid dense clouds of steam tainted with the noxious gas known as sulphuretted hydrogen.”

★ On 10th May 1941 the Earl of Dudley officially opened the Miners’ Welfare Institute in Lower Gornal which was equipped with a variety of amenities for recreation and education and was provided for the use of the 1700 employees of the Baggeridge Colliery. The cost of the building was around £20,000 and was funded by the Central Commission of the Miners’ Welfare Commission.

Brierley Hill Samaritans are as vital as ever in supporting the Black Country. For 52 years the Samaritans at Brierley Hill has supported some of the most vulnerable people in our community. The core Samaritans service is the telephone-based national helpline, available 24/7 every day of the year (free to call on 116 123). Whatever people are going through in life, if

they're having a tough time, they can call that number to talk to someone. All Samaritans are trained volunteers – none are paid for their time – and they are there to listen, focus on thoughts and give people space to explore their feelings.



of other locations, attended Pride events, handed out leaflets and mental health tips at local Supermarkets and given talks to a variety of groups.

As with all charities around the country, regular funding is a major cause for concern to the Samaritans. Brierley Hill is an affiliated branch of the National Samaritans Charity, but it is also an independent charity in itself (registered Charity Number 1168020) and is entirely self-funded. Through a generous bequest some years ago, the branch is fortunate to operate from a purpose-built building, Beryl Hill, on Albion Street just off Brierley Hill High Street. However, in order to continue to operate they must cover their own annual branch running costs which are now approximately £25,000 a year. Volunteers specifically for the Fundraising and Outreach teams are therefore always a vital part of the branch.

The 80 volunteers at Brierley Hill Samaritans are also keen to make a difference out in the local community, attending outreach and awareness events throughout the year. In the last year, they have attended post-incident prevention work at railway stations following suicides on the railways locally), held awareness events at Merry Hill and a number

It is interesting to note that 80% of people who contact the Samaritans do not express suicidal feelings at the time they are calling. However, by calling when they are having a tough time, they may have taken an important first step in allaying further despair by accessing a service where they are listened to in confidence, and they can talk freely without being judged.

Samaritans support and empower callers by helping them to explore their emotions and clarify what is causing their distress.

Hopefully by doing so they can then make sense of their situation and see a way forward. Every life lost to suicide is a tragedy and it is the vision of all who work for the Samaritans that fewer people die by suicide. Between 2021-2023 Dudley registered 8.8 suicides per 100,000 people, the highest rise in deaths for decades. Every death by suicide creates a ripple in our communities too, on average it is



estimated that 135 people are affected every time someone takes their life. This includes family, friends, work colleagues and the wider community. It is clear that the need for the Samaritans service is as vital today as it was in 1973, when a dedicated group of local people first came together to form the Brierley Hill branch. Although Brierley Hill Branch is not always open, they are linked with other branches in such a way so that anyone who calls, whatever the time of day or night, is able to speak to a volunteer.

ORDER IN COURT!

An incident on 27 April 1779 at Sedgley Court House caused an outrage throughout the village.

As the entry in the court records shows: “*Wm Southwick, gentleman during the Sitting of this court with great force and violence with a wooden club or stick of the value of one penny which he then and there held in his hands did assault and strike Wm Bennett, Deputy Beadle of this Manor, in the mouth and thereby knocked out two of his teeth and so drew blood from the same Wm Bennett.*”

Bennett was a popular man in and around Sedgley. Although his duties included bringing wrong-doers to court, he was accepted as an honest and fair man with more compassion than most in his position. The assault on him was therefore considered a serious crime and at his subsequent trial Southwick was fined 39 shillings and 11 pence.

“A SORDID AFFAIR”

Under the headline “A Sordid Affair” in January 1918 the County Express published the story of how John Stott (57), a boatman of Great Bridge, Tipton was charged with damaging an oil painting, two pairs of boots, a suit of clothes, a cloth jacket, a pair of riding breeches, a khaki jacket, two shirts, an overcoat, a felt hat, two padlocks and a wooden clothes box, all belonging to Nebo Littlewood.

When he appeared in court Stott pleaded not guilty and a full trial took place with witnesses having to give evidence. It seems that Littlewood had been lodging with a woman called Charlotte Harrison and on the day in question he left the house at 6.00am to go to work as normal. When he returned at about 5.15pm he found that the damage had been done to his property which had been in his locked bedroom. In cross examination he was asked if he was sleeping with Mrs Harrison. He replied emphatically ‘No’. The solicitor for Stott then asked why were some of Mrs Harrison’s undergarments were found in his room but Littlewood could give no explanation.

Next up to give evidence was Mrs Harrison who said that she was estranged from her husband (although she occasionally stayed with him) and agreed that she had had a relationship with Stott and that he had been sending her money. She said that on the day in question she had taken Littlewood his lunch to him at work and that when she returned home she found the door to Littlewood’s room had been broken and clearly damage had been done.

At this point Stott stood up and said that he was changing his plea to guilty and that he had only ever denied the charge because he wanted the whole story to come out into the open. He said that he had been having an affair with Mrs Harrison and that whilst he could forgive her spending the odd night with the husband from whom she was separated, he was consumed with jealousy when he found out that Littlewood too was sleeping with her. The magistrates fined him £3 plus ordered compensation of £10.

My friend, David Humphries, a fellow pupil at Stourbridge King Edward VI, was a wealth of knowledge on local history and technical subjects. When doing National Service, I recall him telling me of all the masses of wireless apparatus of which he was in charge when on expedition with his officer—who also came from the local Midlands. ‘Come on Humph, get all the gear on the truck and let’s get going!’

David was fascinated by all the science behind the making of coal gas—when at Tipton Gasworks. After, David had a spell with his father’s Ocker Hill milk business which led to superviseship with Midland Counties Dairies.

Later on when he was Manager at Littlewoods Stores there was a week when he worked nearly 130 hours, “we had ladies dresses retailing at £1.99.”

David, in one of our phone chats told me all that there was to know about the Oystermouth Horse Drawn Rail Service. David worked in managerial roles for a scaffolding firm and the West Midlands County Council’s Highways Department—accidents to highways road furniture sometimes demanded very sensitive dealings with folk who had suffered injury or personal loss.

- ★ In February 1910 it was reported in the local papers that a local man, Thomas Smith, suffered a dreadful death. He planned to walk from Sedgley to Bilston and decided to take a short cut across fields rather than keep to the roads. There had been heavy flooding in the area and it seems that whilst walking across the fields he had stumbled into a ditch and his legs were encased in three feet of mud. He was found the following day having been frozen to death.
- ★ The Sedgley Beacon tower was built in 1846 and is 50 feet high and 7 feet in diameter. Although it is often said that it was built by Lord Wrottesley for him to pursue his interests in astronomy, it is more likely to have been constructed by a local landowner (Mr Petit) as a folly.
- ★ In February 1881 Henry John Llewellyn (alias James Brown, alias William Brown Edwards) of Tipton appeared in court accused of bigamy. At the time his profession was given as "evangelist". He and Mary Anne Davies first met when they both joined The Life Boat Crew Temperance Society in Halesowen. Romance blossomed and eventually they married—the only problem was that Llewellyn/Brown/Edwards seems to have forgotten that he was already married at the time!
- ★ On 2nd March 1901 Gornal Wood village saw the opening of a branch of the Dudley Co-op in Zoar Street. The shop was an immediate success and it was quickly extended into the next door premises so that a haberdashery department could be added. Early managers of the shop included Charlie Pratt and Ted Bennett Senior who eventually became President of the Society.
