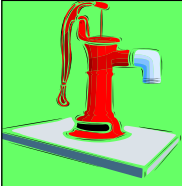

No booking is required. For more information please call us on 01384 231232.

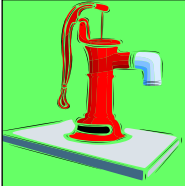

## MEN'S BOWLS AT WORDSLEY COMMUNITY CENTRE

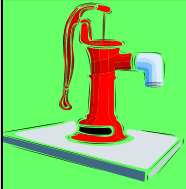
