THE FORGOTTEN STAFFORDSHIRE WORKHOUSE

The Seisdon Union served the communities of Bobbington, Codsall, Enville, Himley, Kinver, Pattingham, Upper Penn, Lower Penn, Tettenhall, Trysull, Seisdon, Wombourne, Woodford Grange, and Rudge. Purpose-built in 1860, its imposing workhouse stood at Trysull for almost a decade. Despite its scale and significance, it has slipped quietly from public memory.

Join historian Andrew Sloane as he explores the hidden histories of this significant yet overlooked institution and its impact on local communities.

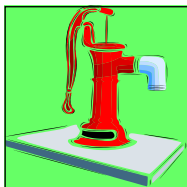

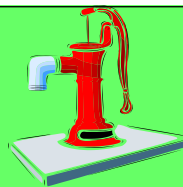
